World Cup 2014 Soccer Pool How to Register

1. From the main site, click on the registration link "REGISTER NOW ONLINE" to begin.



2. **Contact Information:** Enter your Contact Name, Username to be shown on the leader board, Email Address to contact you at and what Entrant Group you will belong to.

Entrant Group details:

By default, everyone joins the **Master** pool and competes against everyone else. But in some cases, smaller office pools can be organized in which case common entrants want to be group together under a single view. If you are in one of these sub-pools, someone would have mentioned this to you and asked you to select that particular Entrant Group from the pull-down menu. If in doubt, please select the default **Master**.

Once complete, please press NEXT.




3. **Group Stage:** For each game, select the result of who you think will win or a tie using the pull-down menu. Once all games have been selected, please press NEXT.




4. **Knockout Stages:** In this step, you will select each of the teams that you think will make the Round of 16, Quarter Finals, Semi Finals, Final and the Champion.


Based on your group stage selections, the top 2 teams in each group will be pre-selected for you. If you want to make any changes, feel free to select whatever 2 teams from each group you like. Use the CTRL key and your mouse to make multiple selections. Your selections will be highlighted. Once you are happy with these selections, press the ADD button under the group boxes.




5. The teams you selected from step (4) will appear in the Round of 16 box. The knockout format used to determine who will play who is located at the bottom of the page. Choose 8 teams from the Round of 16 box that you think will make the Quarter Finals. Use the CTRL key and your mouse to make multiple selections. Once complete, press the ADD button under the Round of 16 box.




6. The teams you selected from step (5) will appear in the Quarter Finals box. The knockout format used to determine who will play who is located at the bottom of the page. Choose 4 teams from the Quarter Finals box that you think will make the Semi Finals. Use the CTRL key and your mouse to make multiple selections. Once complete, press the ADD button under the Quarter Finals box.




7. The teams you selected from step (6) will appear in the Semi Finals box. The knockout format used to determine who will play who is located at the bottom of the page. Choose 2 teams from the Semi Finals box that you think will make the Finals. Use the CTRL key and your mouse to make multiple selections. Once complete, press the ADD button under the Semi Finals box.



8. The teams you selected from step (7) will appear in the Finals box. Choose the team from the Finals box that you think will win the 2014 World Cup. Once complete, press the ADD button under the Finals box.



9. At this point, your Champion selection from step (8) will be displayed and once you are happy with all your knockout selections you can press NEXT to continue.



10. **Top Goal Scorers:** Choose 3 players from any team in the tournament that you think will score the most amount of goals. Only goals scored in regulation time or extra time will count. Goals scored in a penalty shootout to determine a match winner will NOT count.

Type your players' name in each box and select the team that they play for from the drop down menu.

Once complete, please press NEXT.




11. **Tie Breaker:** In case there is a tie at the end of the tournament between the top finishers, a tie breaker will be used to determine the proper placements. The tie breaker will be to choose the total number of goals scored in the tournament without going over.

Please enter your answer in the box provided. Once complete, please press NEXT.



12. **Validate Information:** All your selections will be displayed on the screen for you to verify. If you wish to change any of your selections, please click on the appropriate EDIT link in the lower right side of each editable section. This will take you back to the screen for that section, where edits can be made. Once satisfied, you can step through the registration steps from that point onwards until you reach the validation stage again.




13. Once you are happy with your selections, please take a moment to let us know where you reside and how you were referred to this pool. Please click on the option that best suits you scenario. If a friend referred you, please click Friend and type in that person's name in the box provided.

Please click on the payment method that you will use to enter the pool. If paying by cash, the pool organizer will contact you on how payment can be made. If paying by Paypal, a link will be provided at the next screen for you to make your payment to roecken@rogers.com. If paying by Interac e-Transfer, please use your financial institution's payment system to send payment to roecken@rogers.com.

Lastly, to enter the pool you must be 19 years of age or older. To confirm this, please check the box next to this question confirming you meet the minimum age requirements.

Once complete, please press SUBMIT to enter the World Cup 2014 Soccer Pool.



14. **Confirmation:** After pressing SUBMIT in step (12), you will be presented with a confirmation email saying that you have successfully entered the pool. An email with your selections will also be sent to the email address that was provided.

If you chose Paypal as your payment option, an additional link will be provided to Paypal to make your payment.



This concludes the registration process.
